#### ARTICLE 1 OBJECTIVES

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is to outline the understandings on which Justice Institute of British Columbia and Yukon College will explore, develop, and carry out collaborative activities.

#### ARTICLE II SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

The scope of collaboration on academic and applied research activities under this Memorandum of Understanding may include, but is not limited to, the following:

1. Transfer of students from and articulation of courses and programs to encourage such transfers;
2. Develop and implement collaborative courses, programs or projects of mutual interest and benefit considering respective institutional mandates;
3. Exchange information and expertise to strengthen and expand educational pathways for students at both institutions including joint pilot program(s);
4. Collaborate in scholarly activity such as professional development, applied research partnerships, and joint proposal submissions.

#### ARTICLE III CONTRIBUTION BY BOTH PARTIES

Signature of the Memorandum of Understanding does not entail any material, financial or other obligation for either of the two institutions. Specific initiatives are to be considered and agreed upon, on a case by case basis, including the contributions and obligations of each institution.


